



AT THE BOOK TABLE: Keeping Your Kids on God's Side by Natasha Crain is not only an apologetics books for parents to use with kids, it's for everyone. Forty questions answered in short summaries about things you've always wanted to know but didn't want to read a 500-page book to find out. You may even know the answers, but not be sure how to articulate and explain them. Voila, here is your book. Questions like, why did God command the Israelites to kill all the Canaanites? Do all religions point to the same truth? Is faith the opposite of reason? What are the facts of the resurrection that nearly all scholars agree on? Why are there so many denominations? Does the Bible support slavery? Does the Bible have errors and contradictions? What about old

earth and young earth views of creation? etc. There is a section on how to have deeper faith conversations with your kids that alone is worth the price of the book (a measly \$13).



I also have a copy of *Finding Truth* by Nancy Pearcey, which is the book I am using to teach the *Truth Matters* apologetics class. Peter instructs us that we should "Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the *reason* for the hope that is in you." We all (our kids especially) need apologetics to be able to answer the questions and challenges that come our way from the unbelieving world. Studying apologetics deepens our faith and increases our joy, as we discover more and more ways the Bible really is *total truth* about all of reality. -Lynn B.
