


## STAY FOR LUNCH After the 2<sup>nd</sup> Service

**TEEN CLASS:** Lynn Barton is wrapping up a wonderful summer series called *Truth Matters* – a class designed to equip students with tools for unmasking lies that come their way through unbiblical worldviews. Lynn reports that, "these young people are very interested in the deep questions of theology, like the sovereignty of God, election, human freedom and God's love. They are wrestling and hungry, and asking at a high level. Yet they also are well grounded in the faith, and many seem wise beyond their years."



**NEW TEEN CLASS BEGINS SEPT 4<sup>th</sup>:** What a great report (above) from Lynn! Please pray that God will take the rich teaching from this class and impress it upon hearts and minds, and that He will continue to give our teens confidence in the truth of God's Word, as well as a hunger to know Him more and more. In light of some of these questions related to God's sovereignty, election, human freedom and God's love, Pastor

Brian will lead the teens in a new study through John Piper's book, "Five Points: Toward a Deeper Experience of God's Grace. Concerning this, Piper writes, "My experience is that clear knowledge of God from the Bible is the kindling that sustains the fires of affection for God. And probably the most crucial kind of knowledge is the knowledge of what God is like in salvation. That is what the five points of Calvinism are about. Not the power and sovereignty of God in general, but his power and sovereignty in the way he saves people. That is why these points are sometimes called the doctrines of grace. To experience God fully, we need to know not just how he acts in general, but specifically how he saves us—how he saved me?
