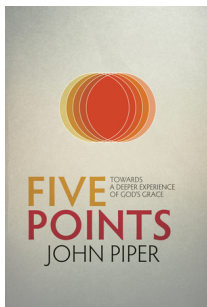


NEW CROSS TRAINING STUDY BEGINS

TODAY: We will be going through the book of Ecclesiastes together during the 2nd service in Cross Training. Find out why many consider this to be a book full of hope that directs our eyes to the Lord.

THIS SUNDAY – LIFE CHAIN 2016: Sponsored by Jackson County Right to Life, Sunday October 2nd – 2:45 to 4:00pm at the corner of Biddle and McAndrews, Medford. Life Chain is a prayer service to end abortion. Signs will be provided, and the organizers give the following instructions: “Upon arrival, warmly greet your fellow Chainers and then begin to pray. Please do not talk. Let us pray and meditate continually, with eyes closed some of the time (if not watching small children), and let us feel free to kneel and pray (please do not lie down). Our need for God’s divine intervention is critical, and we must not waste this precious hour.”

Join Pastor Brian as he leads a discussion group on this very helpful book on the subject of salvation. Why study salvation? As you grow in your understanding of how God saves, you’ll grow in your appreciation for how deep and amazing is the grace of God. Nothing attacks pride, or enhances our love and worship of God better than a deeper understanding of God’s grace; and the 5 points of Calvinism (or “Reformed Theology,” or “The Doctrines of Grace”) lead us (as the subtitle of this book states) “Toward a Deeper Experience of God’s Grace.”

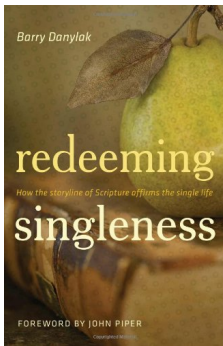
