

NEW AT THE BOOK TABLE: *They Say We are Infidels,* by Mindy Belz. If you are like me, the events of genocide against Christians by ISIS are murky. How has this happened? What does it mean? Mindy Belz has traveled to the Middle East for decades, reporting in World Magazine on events there. This book tells the story of our brothers and sisters at the mercy of unfathomable evil: kidnappings, torture, rape, sexual slavery even of little girls. They have lost everything, continually on the run as ISIS expanded while the world (and our nation) did nothing to stop it. The

world has ignored them, even the Church has, for the most part. I hope this book will change that. Christians have lived in the Middle East for nearly 2,000 years, and already they are almost wiped out. Who will help them? Christianity Today says: "With her vivid personal accounts, Belz puts a human face on grim statistics. Some of these 21st-century martyrs were her friends. After reading *They Say We Are Infidels*, no one can deny their suffering."

Dr. Wayne House is teaching world religions and Dr. Philip Madanat, a Jordanian, is teaching about the effect of mosque preaching on the community. The last is the first time we have offered this course, and we hope that both courses would bring much insight regarding the uniqueness of the Christian faith and message and its potential in a challenging part of the world.
