


THIS COMING THURSDAY We Begin a 6-week class in GROWING U

NEW AT THE BOOK TABLE: The Blessing of Humility by Jerry Bridges. In his last book before going home to meet the Lord, Jerry Bridges explores the Beatitudes and how they teach us the foundational Christian virtue of humility. The book is sold out already and not available for at least two more weeks, but we have one copy. Tim Challies writes, "The one who reads this book will inevitably be convinced of the beauty of humility, convicted of his lack of humility, and encouraged that God loves to help his people grow in this most precious of virtues....In the opening pages Bridges says, 'This book can be read completely in about two hours or less. You may want to do that to get an overview of the book. However, the real value of this book will come as you then read each chapter reflectively and prayerfully. Ask God to help you see yourself as you really are in the light of each of the character

traits covered in the eight Beatitudes. And then ask God to help you grow in the areas where you see yourself to be most needy.' Do it just like that. Read it and consider reading it with a group of friends. You will benefit, they will benefit, and everyone around you will benefit."
