
Operation Christmas Child

NEW AT THE BOOK TABLE: *Finishing our Course with Joy* by J. I. Packer. From the back cover: Thinning hair, failing eyesight, and arthritic hands reveal an inescapable truth: we're only getting older. But that doesn't mean we should simply sit back and take it easy...Renowned theologian and author J. I. Packer challenges us to embrace old age as an opportunity for continued learning, careful planning, and heartfelt discipleship. Packer's pastoral words and personal stories encourage us to press on toward the upward call of God with endurance and grace—that we might continue to glorify God in our aging and finish our lives with joy.



Good & Angry by David Powlison. Can anger ever be good? I've never been quite comfortable with the common teaching that Christians ought never be angry, but did not have a clear picture of the topic, so I'm glad David Powlison has written a whole book about it. There must be a dozen BCC favorite authors recommending this book, including Joni, who writes, "Anger can teach us something good not only about ourselves, but about God—and my friend David Powlison shows us how. I highly recommend Good and Angry, especially for Christian leaders, counselors, parents, and young people!" And John Frame says, "This is the best book on anger there is, except for Scripture itself. Powlison explores

anger with wonderful depth and precise nuance. The book is a great systematic theology, for it explores all the relevance of creation, providence, and saving grace."
