AN UPDATE FROM KIMBERLY MAY: On January 19, 2017, Kimberly's husband, Cody, waded into a lake near Austin, Texas, to meet their children who were floating on a raft near the shoreline. He was not aware of the perilous underwater geography of the lake, and stepped off an underwater shelf, and literally stepped into eternity. A man nearby deployed a flotation device, but was unable to rescue him. The children were rescued safely. The sheriff's office responded, and local search and rescue teams were called out, but their efforts were of no avail. The next morning, the searchers found Cody's body.

Through BCC, you were able to contribute a modest gift toward a fundraiser to help this grieving young widow, and her 7 children. The following is a recent letter from Kimberly,

describing this hard providence, and how God is using it for her good. Look for the entire letter on the lit table.

I have been writing for two months to provide the context for this: my day of deliverance. This story is exceedingly long but there isn't a good way to break it up and every detail is important in that, I believe, it displays God's glory so richly. If you have time to read it, I pray that you will taste a small piece of the much greater redemptive narrative, which He has ordained to accomplish in our midst. Praise Him, all you saints!


On the morning of February 21, 2017, my dead bones were beginning to feel the life-giving breath of God, even as my soul miserably remained antagonistic toward His unfolding purpose in my suffering. After unexpectedly facing one of the songs that was sung on our wedding day, God placed yet another song on my lips. For days, in my journal, I had been writing that I would rather have Cody than God and yet, I began to spontaneously sing "I'd rather have Jesus than anything"...
