








NEW AT THE BOOK TABLE: Praying the Bible by Donald S. Whitney. I recently received this book as a gift and devoured it. It was easy; it's short and truly practical. I loved the opening lines: why do we stop praying? Because it's *boring.* We say the same old things the same old way every time. We can't take it any more, so we stop. Many of us know we should pray scripture, but we don't quite know how to go about it. The author teaches how to do this, and claims that you will never be bored again. I took him up on the challenge, and he's right. I love also that this is the way the ancient church prayed. You can even discern it in the

New Testament once you know what to look for. Jesus may even have been doing it on the cross. Intrigued? I got three copies, and can always get more. Al Mohler says it "has made a huge contribution to my devotional life. This little book is explosive and powerful. Read it ready to experience a great step forward in your walk with Christ and in your commitment to prayer."



Someone I Love Died by Christine Harder Tangvald. This lovely, biblically based book is to help children aged 4-8 with their questions when someone they love dies. It also includes a guide for parents in talking to their children about death. The author writes, "My wish is that this book might provide a tangible tool of comfort, security, and help for children and adults as you face a difficult loss. Jesus loves you. I love you."
