NEW AT THE BOOK TABLE: Honest Evangelism by Rico Tice. There are two kinds of Christian books that depress me. The first kind: most marriage books. (You and Me Forever is a welcome exception!) The second kind are books on evangelism. I get all excited about them, try to do what they say, fall on my face, and slink away in defeat. Don't you hate it when those who love evangelizing tell you it's easy, just use their simple method? (Only extroverts with the gift of evangelism could say that. And they are the ones who write the books.) Honest Evangelism is not like that. You have to love a book whose author begins "I find evangelism hard." It is not a how-to manual. It is not a Seven Easy Steps to leading friends, family, strangers on the plane and gas station attendants to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ. One of my favorite

chapters is "Be Yourself." In other words, you don't have to try to be that guy who wrote all the how-to-evangelize books. If you are him, God bless you! You don't need this book anyway. But for the rest of us, this is a really encouraging book. It doesn't let us off the hook, but frees us from some burdens we don't need to carry, offers some practical tools, and challenges us to put our hope in the sovereign Ruler and Rescuer of the universe.



REFUGEE UPDATE FROM DARLENE BOCEK: We are so thankful to the generous friends who sent funds for the Christian refugees from Syria and Iran. We had more than enough to help them initially, and to continue helping them.

Let me tell you about one lady and her daughter, Iranian refugees. To escape a horrible situation in Iran, she fled to Turkey, carrying her three-year-old daughter in her arms as she trekked on foot for 8 hours across the mountains between Iran and Turkey. They were shot at by border patrol and ended up hiding in a stable. But in the end she was captured by border guards and put into an illegal immigration jail for six

months. In the end, UN took on her case, and she has refugee residency in the meanwhile. While in jail she heard about Christ.

I met her when I was visiting friends one day, and before she knew I was a Christian she told me she was looking for a church. She has started attending our church, and she and I have begun a weekly Bible study to learn the basics of the faith. She is truly a new Christian, yet has a very deep heart of gratefulness to God her Father. I wish you could meet her. She has an amazing, resilient spirit.

She and others like her will be benefitting from the groceries and necessities we will be able to give, due to the generosity of our friends who responded to our call for help. There are more than 40,000 Christian refugees in Turkey, mostly from Syria. Through your support we are able to help people like these.
