

SUMMER STUDY IN CROSSTRAINING: Few stories contain heroism, betrayal, ricocheting monarchs, bold stands against repressive authorities, and redemption like this one. And fewer generations have modeled commitment to the gospel and the application of God's Word like the Puritans of England. In this 12-part series, Dr. Michael Reeves surveys Puritan theology and the work of the Holy Spirit when the Reformation flourished in England. Major milestones of this movement underscore the Puritan's special place in history, as they displayed spiritual wisdom and discernment still benefiting pulpits and believers today. READ SCRIPTURE HOME GROUP: The main emphasis of this home group will be coming together in community to get into the habit of reading Scripture; not simply as chapters and verses, but as stories and narratives. In the Old Testament, Israel gathered together to hear the book of the Law read aloud, in full, and we believe there is great value in reading each book of the bible from cover to cover. We will pick a book from the sixty-six each week to be read from beginning to end in one sitting by a reader, while the rest of the group listens to the book being read aloud. The longest books will be divided naturally, instead of by chapters, to keep the flow of the story. Afterwards, we will discuss what we've read and dive into some of the details and thematic elements. We will begin this weekly home group on Friday, June 16, at 6:30pm at the Hoehne household in Eagle Point. The first week we will read 1 Timothy, so you are encouraged to read and study and meditate on this book throughout the prior week. We hope to see you there! NEW AT THE BOOK TABLE: Family Worship Bible Guide, Joel Beeke, General Editor. This would have been great to have when my kids were growing up. Extracted from the Reformation Heritage Bible, this book "presents rich devotional thoughts on all 1,189 chapters in the Bible, including searching questions to promote conversation, to help you with this responsibility. Use this resource every day alongside Scripture to read each chapter's major takeaways aloud and then discuss them with your family."

I also have two more copies of *Praying the Bible* by Donald Whitney. The first three copies quickly sold, and I've been told by one person this book was a great help. It certainly has been to me. Its main focus is praying the psalms, but it can be applied to all of scripture. Short, simple, and immediately applicable to helping us pray more often, more effectively, and with more joy.
